- **Centreline**, the school's yearbook, is produced by students of Class 11. It is a keepsake of their time at The C.A.S. School.
- **Neemtree**, the school newspaper is printed quarterly. Students of Class 10 cover school related events through pictures, articles and interviews.

History of the School

The C.A.S. School was founded in 1981. Within its first few years it had established itself as a leading private school in Karachi. With its modern approach, the school has come to be known for its innovative teaching practices. In January 2005 the Junior and Senior Sections shifted from rented (residential) premises to the present custom-built Main Campus. A diversified Programme of Studies could now be offered on a more expanded and elaborate scale for students to experience a wider intellectual canvas and learning opportunities. The Kindergarten Section moved into its purpose-built campus, located behind the Main Campus, in January 2009.

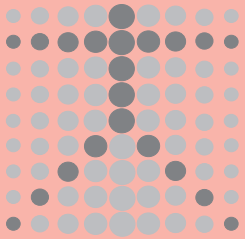
Sami Mustafa is the Founder-Principal of The C.A.S. School. He is also the Executive Director of Book group (a non-profit educational research organization) and Executive Director of the Sindh Education Reform Initiative (SERI). He has a Bachelor's degree in Philosophy and a Master's degree in Political Science from the University of California at Santa Barbara and a Master's degree in Political Economy/Sociology from the State University of New York at Binghamton. He is the author of 42 colourful and child-friendly books in English and Urdu for younger children.

Today, the C.A.S. offers a 14-year programme from Playgroup to O-Level (Cambridge Assessment International Education, CAIE, UK). It has a total of 1,380 students, 205 teaching members and 126 Admin/Support staff in the two campuses.
