

Competing with 519 participants from 27 leading schools of Karachi and a school from UAE, the 73-member C.A.S. Rowing Team won 13 gold medals, 9 silver medals and 15 bronze medals. The team also won a trophy for the U-18 Junior Boys and the President Cup. Saif Malik, Azka Azhar and Maha Fahd received Rower of the Regatta Awards. The C.A.S. secured 1st position with an overall 164 points.

The C.A.S. School


The C.A.S. School was founded in 1981 by Sami Mustafa. He has been the Principal since. In a short span of a few years it had established itself as a leading private school in Karachi. With its modern approach, the school has come to be known for its innovative teaching practices. In January 2005 the Junior and Senior sections shifted from rented (residential) premises to the present custom-built Main Campus. A diversified Programme of Studies could now be offered on a more professional scale for students to develop a wider intellectual canvas and learning opportunities. The Kindergarten Section moved into its purpose-built campus, located behind the Main Campus, in January 2009.

Today, The C.A.S. School offers a 14-year programme from Playgroup to O-Level (Cambridge Assessment International Education, UK). It has a total of 1,400 students, 205 teaching members and 126 Admin/Support staff in the two campuses.

Founding-Principal

Sami Mustafa is the Founder-Principal. He is also the Executive Director of Bookgroup, a non-profit educational research organization. He has a Bachelors degree in Philosophy and a Masters degree in Political Science from the University of California at Santa Barbara and a Masters degree in Sociology from the State University of New York at Binghamton. He is the author of 52 colourful and child-friendly books in English and Urdu for younger children. Published in March 2022, The Miracle of Marine Life is his latest 300-page coffee-table book.
